

What is Society 5.0 in Japan



 - Platform Industrie 4.0 of Germany
 - Robot Revolution Initiative of Japan
- On 28 April 2016, the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) of Japan and the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy (BMWi) of the Federal Republic of Germany released a Joint Statement on Cooperation between METI and BMWi regarding the Internet of Things (IoT) / Industrie 4.0 (hereinafter: Joint Statement)
